#### PLACEMENT OF SIGNS IN ROTARY

(Policy Adopted by Board of Selectmen May 7, 1991)

(See section 10.3.1 of the General Bylaws)

- 1. The sign shall be no larger than 2 feet by 3 feet.
- The purpose of the sign is to promote a local event of general interest to the Carlisle community.
- The sign is not politically partisan in nature. (Signs such as a notice of town meeting dates or those urging voters to vote are acceptable.)
- 4. The sign is concise in it's wording so as not to provide a significant detraction from the attention of passing automobile drivers.
- The period that the sign will be in place is specified. (Typically, permission will be given for periods not longer than one week with possible renewal for a second week.)
- Only one sign will be displayed during the period requested.
