During the event the beverage committee stocks the beverage tables for the waiters/waitresses and serves coffee.

The committee should start soliciting product in late August.

The area merchants who donated the beverages are listed at the bottom of the page. We received 1540 bottles of product and used 1160. The remaining beverages were given to the school cafeteria to be used for future events. We also served approximately 210 cups of coffee. After hearing that very little tea was served in years past this committee decided against having tea for the evening.

200 milk cartons were ordered through the school cafeteria. 110 were used.

There are many cups, stirrers and sugar packets available from past spaghetti suppers.

Starbucks donated a large container of coffee, which served approximately 150 cups. We also had 2 perculators to brew an extra 30 cups of regular coffee and 30 cups or decaf.

On the night of the event we had two people stocking the tables for the servers and 2 people serving coffee throughout the cafeteria. The servers carried filled carafes of regular coffee and a carton of milk for people who requested it. The sugar was placed on the tables prior to the dinner. The decaf was taken directly from the perculators when requested.
